Applicants for Degree Programmes should hold at least EITHER:

- (a) UCE & UACE Certificate with 2 Principal Passes OR
- (b) Diploma from a recognized institution of Higher learning OR
- (c) A Pass in Mature Age Examination

Applicants for Diploma Programmes should hold at least EITHER:

- (a) UCE & UACE Certificate with 1 Principal Pass OR
- (b) Certificate from a recognized institution of Higher learning
- (c) A Pass in Mature Age Examination

Applicants for Postgraduate Programmes

Should hold at least a good first degree from a recognized institution of higher learning

International Applicants

Applicants must have qualifications that are recognized for University entry in their respective countries.
